

Announcement of the intention for Honesty No gift offering, giving or taking for any performance of duties (No gift Policy) Fiscal Year 2024

Preventing and suppressing corruption is one of the important policies of the government and considered as an urgent agenda of the country. It is defined in the 20 year National strategy (2019-2039) which lead to set the Thirteenth National Economic and Social Development Plan (2023-2027) including management in the government sectors to prevent corruption and promote good governance in the Thai society.

As the Director of The Demonstration school, University of Phayao, I would like to announce a policy of no gift offering, giving or taking for any performance of duties (No gift Policy). I hereby declare the management and the carry out of the mission with honesty, integrity, transparency and anti-corruption.

Therefore, in order to demonstrate a commitment to combating corruption in all forms, strengthening transparency within the organization, creating a culture of integrity in the performance of duties and to reduce the risk of corruption and misconduct. I shall set policy as guidelines as follows:

- 1. To maintain ethical standards and transparency, do not solicit or accept gifts or benefits in return for performing work-related duties.
- The administrators and personnel at all levels must adhere to the university's ethical standards and possess a good attitude and a clear conscience. They must perform their duties in a transparent, fair, and verifiable manner.
